Area I: Co-curricular and extra curricular activities

Objectives

- c. Practice skills relative to learning a vocation;
- d. Develop independence, honesty, fair judgment, nationalism and patriotism; spiritual, social and civic consciousness; and care for the environment through the activities provided by the club/organizations wherein they are affiliated.

Area 2: Sports Program/Varsity

Goal. Develop well-trained athletes to represent PSD to various sports competitions.

Objectives

- b. Join in sports competitions sponsored by other agencies/organizations;

Area 3: Student Coordinating Body (Supreme Student Government)
